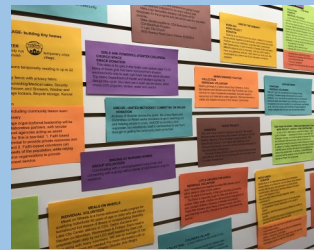

Chancel Choir-Wednesdays at 6:30 pm. (except during the summer) Performs every Sunday and special Christmas programs.

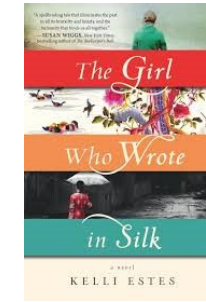

Sunday Worship Services

Worship is the heart of our lives at CUMC, believing that we all have a need to praise God, know Christ and spend time in community doing just those things. While we have similar needs to worship, we offer the following worship experiences:

9am Worship

The Chancel Choir and, occasionally the Community Brass bell choir, provide special music during the school year. Hymns are traditionally accompanied by our historic pipe organ and the worship style is more traditional.

10:30am Worship

This service is a more informal style with contemporary music led by the Worship Team, and occasional special performances.

Children are welcome at both worship services. A nursery is offered for infants to age 3.

Communion is celebrated on the first and third Sundays. All are welcome at the Lord's table.
